Terms and Conditions for participants in courses, events, and coaching.

The general terms and conditions are part of the written registration and must be described by us with all legal details. We generally work with an ethos of collaboration, which means that we will find a solution to your problem together. So please let us know directly if something is not right and we can talk about it.

Here are the official terms and conditions.

(1) Fundamentals

The Terms and Conditions (TC) apply exclusively to all contracts for participation in courses/seminars/conferences offered by Leon Bucher with Creating Regenerative Journeys and Land Regeneration and which a customer or company signs with regard to the events presented in the program.

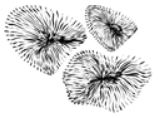
(2) General information on Land Regeneration training and events

The content of the event can be found in the respective course description.

Unless expressly stated otherwise in the description, the stated participation fee applies only to the planned event. The costs for travel, accommodation and meals are not included in the participation fee, unless otherwise stated.

The events are conducted by qualified trainers. Thereby, we work with the utmost care and to the best of our knowledge and belief.

We reserve the right to change trainers or change the venue at short notice and, in exceptional cases, to postpone the planned date to another date. We also reserve the right to replace or



cancel individual lectures or contributions within an event, provided this has no influence on the overall character of the event. There is no right of withdrawal for these reasons.

(3) Registration / Invoicing

Registration for an event, course, or coaching must be made in writing. Registration is binding for the participants. Upon successful registration, participants will receive a confirmation of registration by e-mail. By registering, participants accept our Terms and Conditions. The contract between the participant and us is concluded when the registration confirmation is sent by e-mail.

Registrations will be considered in the order in which they are received.

Before the start of the event, participants will receive an invoice together with further information. The participation fee is due for payment immediately upon receipt of the invoice, at the latest within the payment period stated on the invoice.

We reserve the right to exclude participants from participation if the invoiced amount has not been paid by the start of the event, unless otherwise agreed.

For a single coaching session, the invoice will be sent after the session has been done.

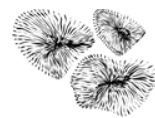
(4) Consumer right of withdrawal for distance contracts

Withdrawal policy:

In accordance with § 312d para. 1 BGB in conjunction with § 355 BGB, you have the right to withdraw from this contract within fourteen days without giving reasons. The withdrawal period is fourteen days from the date of conclusion of the contract.

by means of a clear statement (e.g., an e-mail, or by telephone) of your decision to withdraw from this contract.

To meet the withdrawal deadline, it is sufficient for you to send your notification of exercising your right of withdrawal before the withdrawal period has expired.

Consequences of withdrawal:

In the event of an effective withdrawal, we must refund all payments already received for participation immediately and at the latest within fourteen days of the day on which notification of the withdrawal is received. Repayment will be made by bank transfer to the participant's bank account. Under no circumstances will fees be charged for this repayment.

The right of withdrawal expires prematurely at the time when the training/event begins, should this be earlier than the end of the withdrawal period.

(5) Withdrawal or cancellation of participation and change of participants

Participants may cancel their registration or withdraw from the contract in writing. The date of receipt by Land Regeneration is decisive for compliance with the following deadlines.

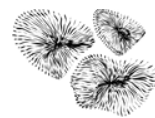
If unable to attend, participants may provide a substitute participant at any time. The registration of a substitute participant does not incur any costs.

Unless otherwise stated, the following cancellation conditions apply. Any costs incurred in the event of cancellation will be offset in the corresponding amount against any advance payments already made.

Cancellation conditions for events up to 3 days or 6 online appointments

If you cancel your participation in an event up to 2 weeks before the event date, no fees will be charged.

If you cancel between the 14th and 8th day before the scheduled date, 25% of the participation fee will be charged.



If you cancel on or after the 7th day before the start of the event or if you do not attend the event, the full fee will be charged.

Cancellation conditions for events lasting more than 3 days or 6 online appointments

If you cancel your participation in an event up to 3 weeks before the event date, no fees will be charged.

If you cancel between the 21st and 14th day before the scheduled date, 25% of the participation fee will be charged.

If you cancel on or after the 13th day before the start of the event or if you do not attend the event, the full fee will be charged.

Cancellation conditions for online coachings

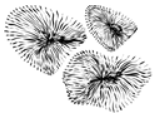
If you cancel your online coaching session up to 24 hours before the date, no fees will be charged.

If you cancel your online coaching session up to 24 hours before the date or in case of a no-show, the full fee will be charged. In individual cases (e.g., illness) and if you contact us directly, the fee may be refunded as a credit for a new appointment.

(6) Cancellation of an event

If an event has to be canceled for unforeseeable reasons for which we are not responsible, in particular in the event of illness of trainers or extraordinary events such as natural disasters or traffic disruptions, as well as other cases of force majeure, we will inform the participants immediately. In the event of the illness of trainers without the possibility of providing a replacement in time, we have the right to postpone the seminar to an alternative date. If an event is canceled without replacement, participants will be refunded any participation fees already paid. In any case, liability is limited exclusively to the participation fee.

Any further claims - in particular with regard to accommodation, train travel, or flights already booked - are excluded.



Compensation claims of any kind against us due to the cancellation of an event are excluded, unless caused by gross negligence or intent.

(7) Minimum number of participants

As a rule, the minimum number of participants for our events is 6, unless otherwise stated. If the minimum number of participants is not reached, we reserve the right to cancel the event. In this case, participants will be refunded the full participation fee.

(8) Liability

We accept no liability for damage of any kind to health or property or loss of items belonging to course participants during the event or on the way to or from the event location. Further liability and claims for damages are excluded, unless they are based on intentional or grossly negligent behavior of Land Regeneration or its vicarious agents.

Liability of us due to unfulfilled expectations is excluded.

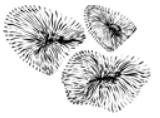
Insurance claims for accidents and damages cannot be asserted against us. We do not provide insurance cover for items brought in. Each participant is liable for lost or stolen items. Participants are obliged to take out the usual insurance against direct or indirect damage.

(9) Jurisdiction and applicable law

The agreement between the participant and us is concluded in accordance with the law of the Federal Republic of Germany. The place of jurisdiction is the current registered office of Land Regeneration, the town of Eppstein.

(10) Data privacy information

1. Participants' data will be processed electronically for internal purposes. The data associated with the registration will be stored in compliance with the applicable statutory data protection regulations.



2. Precise details of name, address, telephone number, email address, and, if applicable, date of birth are required to process the registration. The personal data will be used by us exclusively for the purpose of fulfilling the contract. Participants can obtain information about the data stored about them at any time. Your personal data will not be passed on, sold, or otherwise transferred to third parties unless this is necessary for the processing of the communicated or agreed purposes (e.g., to cooperation partners or the seminar management) or you have expressly consented to this.

(11) Subsidiary agreements

Changes to the concluded contract must be made in writing; this also applies to amendments to the written form clause. The participants confirm with their signature that no verbal collateral agreements have been made.

Should one of the provisions of these GTC be invalid, this shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions.
